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### YEAR 3 PHYSICS PHY342 PROJECT ORALS 2016-17

Enclosed are the project reports for marking and examining. A draft timetable for oral examinations is attached. If you cannot manage the time(s) suggested, please consult with your fellow examiner and let the students know an alternative time as soon as possible. (If you also inform me, I will keep the version on the web up to date.) Also enclosed are paper copies of the assessment material which is also available on the web – the Report Forms together with a Project Marking Scheme that indicates what level of attainment is required for each mark category. On the Project Assessment Form you should allocate marks (%) as indicated for each of the categories, noting the items to be taken into consideration in each case. I hope that the sheet describing the marking scheme is clear without further explanation.

Note that the Project Attempt mark will be allocated by the Supervisor, whilst the marks for the Report and Oral should be allocated separately by the Supervisor and Assessor and the average taken. Where there is disagreement or a large deviation between the separate marks the Year Tutor should be consulted and, if necessary, will act as arbitrator.

Supervisors should return the laboratory notebook to the students at or soon as possible after the oral examination. (*In the past, this has often been forgotten!!*)

May I remind you of the **other requirements?**

1. At the beginning of each oral the student should be given approx. **5 minutes** to provide an **overview** of the work. (Students have been told to expect this.) This is intended to help develop presentational skills.
2. **Feedback for students** should be provided, indicating to them where their strengths and weaknesses lie. This feedback is essential if we expect students to learn from their attempt and to improve their performance during subsequent project work. The report need not be long, but indicated on the sheet are some of the topics which you **may** wish to refer to. These are just to remind you which aspects may require **constructive** comment. In response to staff requests, there is no longer a separate feedback form. The second side of the form will be copied and made available to the student. **Please return the assessment form to me, together with one copy of the report** for each student examined.
